SUBJECT: SPOT FY 2018 FUNDING REQUEST

DESCRIPTION/BACKGROUND:

The Selkirks-Pend Oreille Transit Authority (“SPOT”) was created by a Joint Powers Agreement to which the City of Sandpoint is a member. SPOT was created to establish, implement, maintain, fund and operate a public transportation system for the benefit of the members’ commuters, residents and visitors.

The financial operations, including a preliminary annual operating budget, is overseen by the Board of SPOT and the JPA requires that a preliminary budget be submitted to the members of the JPA prior to April 10th each year. The SPOT Board determines the pro-rata share of each member and establishes the time period for when the payment is due. Payment is subject to approval of the governing board of each member, which in the case of the City of Sandpoint is the City Council.

SPOT has requested a contribution in the amount of \$78,000 from the City of Sandpoint for Fiscal Year 2018. Last year’s contribution was \$70,000. In addition to presenting this request, SPOT will also provide an annual report of operations and financial affairs as required by the JPA.
