City Projects

Stephen Drinkard participated in a discussion on general concepts for moving the Arts Commission goals forward and working with members of the arts community, the City Council, the Downtown Revitalization Committee, DSBA, etc. Stephen talked about issues that he believed would be a concern to the City if a public art project included benches, such as durability of materials, maintenance and cost. Stephen indicated that upon request and approval from the Mayor and City Council, he could be available to assist in making grant applications.

Cindy Elliott will ask City Staff to review the Jack Makie video at one of their weekly staff meetings as the first step before asking for a city workshop to screen the video for the Council and Mayor, Planning Commission, DSBA, Downtown Revitalization Steering Committee and the public.

The new Parks and Recreation Director, Kim Woodruff will be invited to the Commission's October 2004 meeting to talk about upcoming parks projects that could be considered for inclusion of art in the functional elements.
