Rebecca Holland called the meeting to order at 1:30 PM; Sandy Lamson took minutes.

1. Minutes for the November 19, 2013, meeting were approved. **Motion Steve Berenson, second Bill Krause, approved.**
2. Molly said that since City Council passed the Complete Streets Resolution, an ADA-compliant signal (chirping) is needed at Superior and the Bypass. She notified Kody Van Dyk. **Motion Molly O'Reilly, second Steve Brenson, approved: Sandpoint Pedestrian & Bicycle Advisory Committee recommends that Sandpoint's Public Works Department adopt a standard that all newly-installed traffic signals or those that have major reworking be made fully ADA accessible in the process.**
3. Community Choices for Idaho (CC4I) grant: Using the Complete Streets Resolution, Bruce Robertson is designing a bike route from Dog Beach to Bridge Street, along 1st Avenue. Alternatives: When 1st Avenue is two-way, bikes will be accommodated. Existing bike path goes through the Courthouse parking lot (not ideal). Molly O'Reilly suggested narrower traffic lanes to slow traffic. The grant applications are submitted in sections, the Superior part first. Letter of intent is due Monday. Superior and 1st Avenue may become a roundabout. **Motion Molly O'Reilly, second Bill Krause, approved: The design must include people's ability to walk from Bridge Street to Dog Beach trail safely.** The balance was tabled until next month.
4. The Planning Department is interested in bicycle parking standards to influence future building. The San Francisco standard looks good. Rebecca Holland and Steve Berenson will study the issue and report back.
5. Rebecca Holland discussed the progress of the Educational Committee's *Bonner County Daily Bee* series of 200-word articles, per the outline she presented.
6. The next meeting will be Wednesday, January 15, 2014.
