Councilman Reuter has been working with Tess Howell an intern for the Parks, Rec, & Trails Master Plan to compile a survey designed to gauge park use, wants, and needs. They intend to distribute to Sandpoint Citizens by the end of July. Director Woodruff suggested that a tri-fold listing/map of all Parks in City limits be distributed along with the survey.
