**MINUTES**

The minutes for April 22, 2013, were approved as presented.

**ANNOUNCEMENTS FROM CHAIR**

Chair noted that new Arbitrative had been planted on the west side of City Beach. Director informed that they were planted as part of the surface water pre-treatment swale in that same area.

**PARK HOURS**

After a short presentation from Police Chief Coon the Commission discussed tackled the issue of park operation hours. The current code prohibits overnight camping but does not include specific language park-wide for open and closure. After debate a motion was made by Commissioner McClelland and seconded by Commissioner DuBuisson that a recommendation be forwarded to the City for park closure hours from 12 Midnight to 4am. The vote was unanimous.

**FARMIN BANDSTAND**

The Bandstand is currently managed as a parks shelter for rental purposes. The City wishes to work with user groups to encourage use. Though no formal action was taken the Commission discussed levels of noise, family friendly events and lyrics, and ending activities no later than 10pm.

**ANNOUNCEMENTS FROM DIRECTOR**

Rotary will “hand over the keys” to the Bandstand during the Taste of Sandpoint event on June 27<sup>th</sup>. The Pine Street playground project is proceeding well. An investment was made to install security cameras at the City Beach Snack Shack.
